Every year millions of wildebeest make their way from the Serengeti across the plains of the Maasai Mara in search of fresh pasture. This annual life and death marathon struggle driven by animal instinct has become the stuff of legend and is one of the great draws to Kenya for many.

The most dramatic moments of the migration take place at the river crossings when hundreds of wildebeest, often with accompanying zebra and gazelle, launch themselves off the banks of the Mara River into crocodile-filled murky waters to swim for their lives.

As brutal as it is awe-inspiring, the great migration is a story best told in pictures.
